Online coordinator responsibilities-

- Develop RWP's IAW EN-RP-105 to support online scope.
- Develop ALARA plans to support online work. (>50 mR)
- Initiate Temporary Shielding requests for both units for online activities.
- Assign RWP's and Dose estimates to Online Work Orders and manual activities.
- Perform RWP closeouts IAW EN-RP-105 online and outage.
- Track RWP dose and perform In-progress reviews.
- Status RP, RW and decon activities in Syntempo during outages.
- Status RP, RW and decon activities in Syntempo during online activities.
- Maintain Emergency Response Organization qualifications and participate in required drills and exercises.
- Maintain hot spot and leaker database.
- Responsible for T-16 meetings/reviews

- Reviewing and tracking exposure by Department, work group and other classifications.

- Ensuring that meeting minutes of the ALARA Managers Committee and the ALARA Sub-Committee are documented, reviewed and approved.
- Supplying ALARA data and trend analysis as appropriate to the ALARA Managers Committee.
- Input Devonway data and develop quarterly comparison with PWR in the US.
- Scheduling and conducting ALARA Sub-Committee meetings.
- Administration of the emergent work authorization process, estimating, and tracking.
- Reviewing on-line and outage schedules.
- Conducting the RP Risk Assessment Meeting.
